### **Location:**

### **Driving Directions to Nordstrom Store and Parking:**

#### **I-5 Heading Northbound:**

Take Seneca Street exit (left side of freeway) to 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue.  
Turn right on 6<sup>th</sup>, go approx. 5 blocks, cross Pine Street.  
Pacific Place garage will be on right; Nordstrom is on left.  
Park in garage, return to 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue level. Cross the street to get to Nordstrom.

#### **I-5 Heading Southbound:**

Take the Union St. exit to 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and turn right.  
Go approx. 2 blocks, cross Pine Street.  
Pacific Place parking garage will be on right, Nordstrom is on left.  
Park in garage, return to 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue level, and cross the street to Nordstrom.

### **IMPORTANT: Entering Nordstrom:**

**Use 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue entrance marked “Corporate Offices,”** across the street from Pacific Place parking garage, to right of Nordstrom valet parking window.  
This is the **ONLY ENTRANCE OPEN TO US**. Upon entering, go to right and **take the elevators to 5<sup>th</sup> floor**. There will be signs directing you to the J.W. Nordstrom room.

### **Returning to Pacific Place parking garage:**

**YOU MUST PAY YOUR PARKING FEE AT THE 6<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE LEVEL. YOU CANNOT PAY FROM YOUR CAR AS YOU LEAVE.** You will be an unhappy person if you don't remember this. We will remind you at the seminar before you leave!

## Additional Transportation Information:

**Bicycle Riders:** If you are riding a bicycle and are looking for a place to store it while at the session, here is a link that should help you find a location that fits your needs:
